

**Texas Association Teachers of Dancing, Inc.
2022 Floor Show Policy**

1. One dance per member teacher.
2. Each junior, senior student or assistant performing must be registered and participating in the convention classes.
3. A registered member teacher may present one routine no longer than 3 minutes **OR** if two registered member teachers from the same studio agree, one routine no longer than 5 minutes with at least six dancers may be presented. Only one 5 minute production per studio may be performed in the floorshow. This will count as 2 member teacher dances as referred to in floor policy #1 above.
4. No student or assistant will be allowed to perform in more than two numbers in the floor show. (including a solo)
5. A Student may only perform in 1 solo number not to exceed 2 minutes in length.
6. A student may perform in either two 3-minute routines or one 5-minute production number.
7. Member and Non-Members cannot perform in the floorshow in a student number.
8. The deadline to email music for each dance to hssdstolle@gmail.com (Heather Stolle) is June 20 before the convention.
9. NO student will be added to the floorshow if not performing at the rehearsal.
10. **DO NOT INCLUDE THE FLOORSHOW ENTRY FORM WITH THE REGISTRATION PACKET SENT TO THE TREASURER.**
